Join us on the 22-23rd of September in Budapest, Hungary, at the [Display.Voices conference](#) to kick-start a ground-breaking media platform anchored in public values – built by independent, not-for-profit media organizations.

The two-day program features reflections on the current media ecosystem by independent creators, hands-on workshops on cross-border collaborations and community building, and an introduction to the [Display Europe](#) network with the opportunity to shape the direction as we move forward. The event is organized by [Community Media Forum Europe](#) (CMFE) and [Hostwriter](#) and will be hosted at the [Múosz – National Association of Hungarian Journalists](#).

Newsrooms, independent and community media from all over Europe are invited to join, and participating organizations will have the opportunity to become the first partners in the network of Displ.eu. The platform will provide citizens across the continent with access to both trustworthy information and a picture of Europe that is not usually conveyed by mainstream or national media organizations. Through translation, syndication, and original content, we will gather and disseminate trustworthy community-driven media.

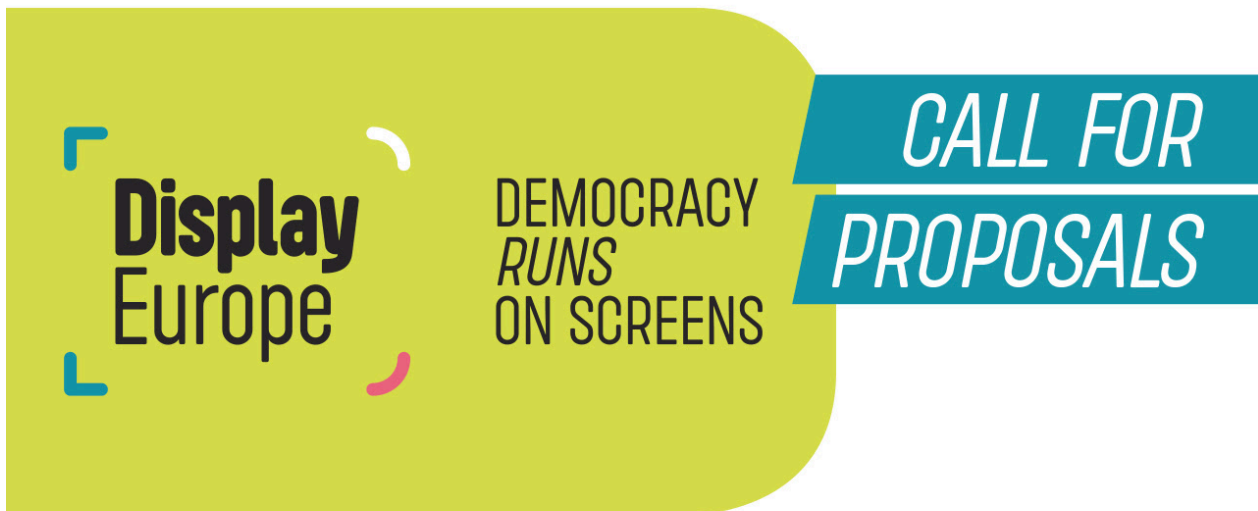

[Display Europe](#) is part of the **Initiative for European Public Space**, a coalition built to shape a European media landscape. The architects of “Display Europe – Democracy runs on Screens” believe in a European media, grounded in public values and inclusivity.

As a result, independent and citizen media are building displ.eu, a European media platform that is open to all citizens in a twofold sense: citizens throughout Europe can receive the media translated into their own language

via a central platform, and European citizens are able to contribute content to the platform via the widespread existing structures of citizens' media.
